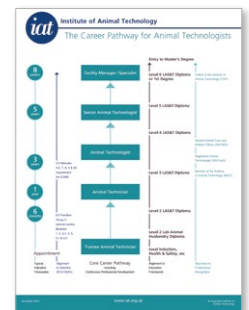
Creating opportunity
